Itinerary

Your private scenic transfer begins with a spectacular aerial view of the Sydney CBD, Harbour Bridge and Opera House before heading west along the Parramatta River towards the Blue Mountains. After crossing the Nepean River your flight climbs to rise above the chiselled sandstone escarpments and the blue hazed Blue Mountains National Park.

Your flight path takes you over the heart of the Greater Blue Mountains World Heritage Area, including the world famous Three Sisters, Echo Point, the Jameson and Megalong Valleys before descending into the Wolgan Valley en route to the Wolgan Valley Resort & Spa.

Transfer Rates

Transfer rates are valid from 1st October 2009 until 31st March 2010. All prices are quoted in Australian Dollars and are inclusive of 10 per cent Service Tax.

*Payload available is expressed as a maximum and is a combination of both passengers and luggage. (Passenger body weights must be supplied prior to confirmation and for legal and safety reasons, all passengers are weighed prior to boarding the helicopter)

Personal luggage should be in soft bags for helicopter transfers. Excess luggage can be stored at the Aviation Tourism Australia's facility at Mascot or delivered to the resort by road at extra charge.

Rate includes:

- Storage of any excess luggage at the Aviation Tourism Australia's facility at Mascot
- Courtesy shuttle bus transfers from both Sydney CBD hotels or domestic and international terminals.
- Complimentary parking is available for self-drive guests.

Note:

- Travel time is between 50-60 minutes one way
- Helicopter can only operate during daylight hours
- Operation is subject to weather conditions
- Sights, flight paths and flight times may vary due to weather, air traffic control or pilot discretion
- Helicopter transfers are not available 25th and 26th December and 1st January 2010.

Cancellation Policy

- Flights cancelled with over 24 hours notice – no charge
- Flights cancelled with 24 hours notice – 50% fee
- Flights cancelled on day of tour – 100% of tour
- If passengers elect not to travel due to weather but flights are still operational, 100% cancellation fee will apply
